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Principal's Message

Why We Teach ?

The student-faculty relationship is the human element of education. Its particular quality was articulated so well by Sir Eric Ashby, the British educator and scholar, when he wrote: "In most fields of knowledge — even in science and technology — the intuitive value judgment, the leap of imagination, the processing of data by analogy rather than by deduction, are characteristic of the best kind of education. We know of no way to elicit these except through dialogue between the teacher and the pupil. The most precious qualities transmitted from teacher to pupil are not facts and theories, but attitudes of mind and styles of thinking." It is the human element that creates the special learning environment one experiences in the classrooms and co-curricular activities such that the mind is not cultivated at the expense of the heart. It is to attain that that we teachers spend our lives within the four walls of the classroom with a group of children trying to consider the logistics of meeting the needs of a class full of overly excited children with vastly divergent learning needs.

As so well said by Prof. Nigel Coutts, teaching is something closely linked to our concept of self. It is part of our nature and our professional practice is an expression of who we are. It connects with a desire to share and to partake in something bigger than ourselves.

An opportunity to make the world a better place by shaping the next generation. We teach because we believe what we do matters and has purpose. There are challenges here for some as the nature of teaching changes. For those drawn by visions of the wise professor dispatching words of wisdom with empowering speeches of wisdom the change to a 'learner centered model' disrupts their patterns of practice and self-concept. The move from the *sage on the stage to the guide by the side* brings new opportunities and, for those with a passion for learning, exciting times.

Principal's Message

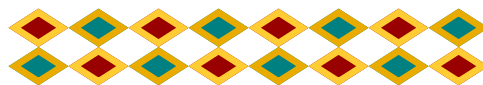

any education.

It is known and accepted worldwide that knowledge is necessary for freedom. However, in present context, the converse also holds true. As Epictetus puts it, “It is impossible for a man to learn what he thinks he already knows”. The boundaries of knowledge, therefore, should always be constantly pushed. This can happen only when educators and educational institutes are given the freedom and flexibility to explore. “One size fits all” rule does not apply to education. Education must be able to address contemporary as well as local issues of the society.

A welcome step in this direction is to grant autonomy to educational institutes. Autonomy shall enable institutions to adapt and become more relevant in terms of time and space. Whether in terms of designing relevant curriculum, adopting novel teaching-learning methods and devising effective evaluation techniques, autonomy is sure to bring about a fresh approach in education.

All these thoughts come to my mind as Bhavan’s College is set to enter into a new era of self-governance and academic autonomy. It is our collective responsibility to use this freedom judiciously and take this great institution to greater heights of excellence.

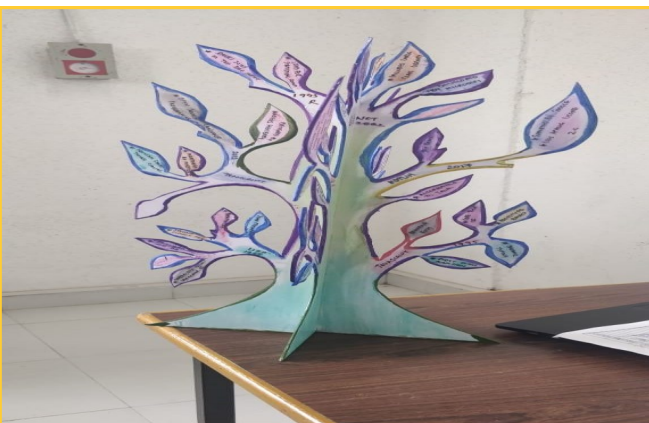


Department of Computer Science

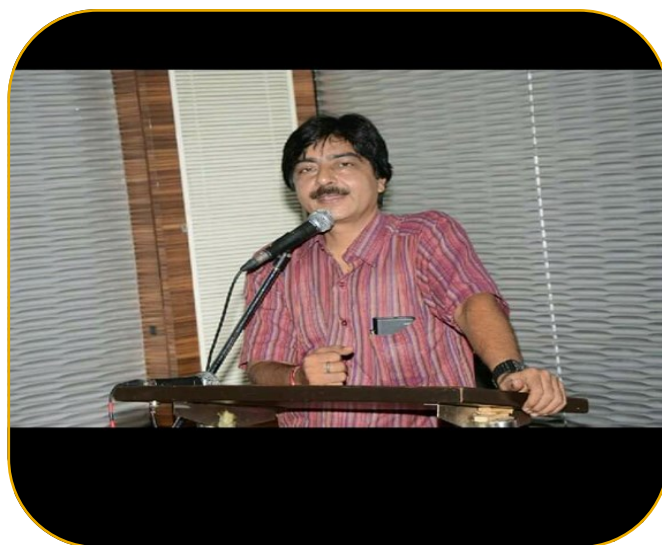
The workshop helped teachers in the new paper pattern for Theory as well as for Practical's, evaluation and making of Blue print for question paper.

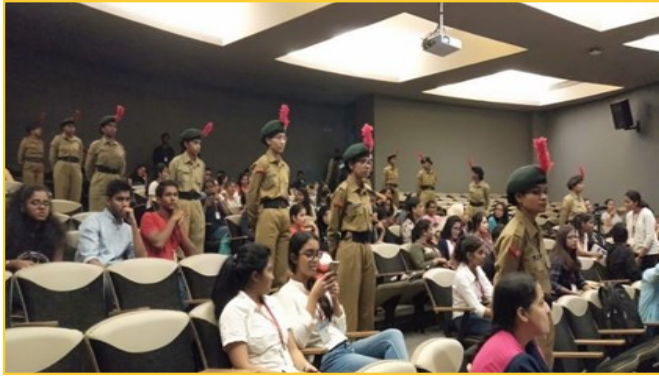

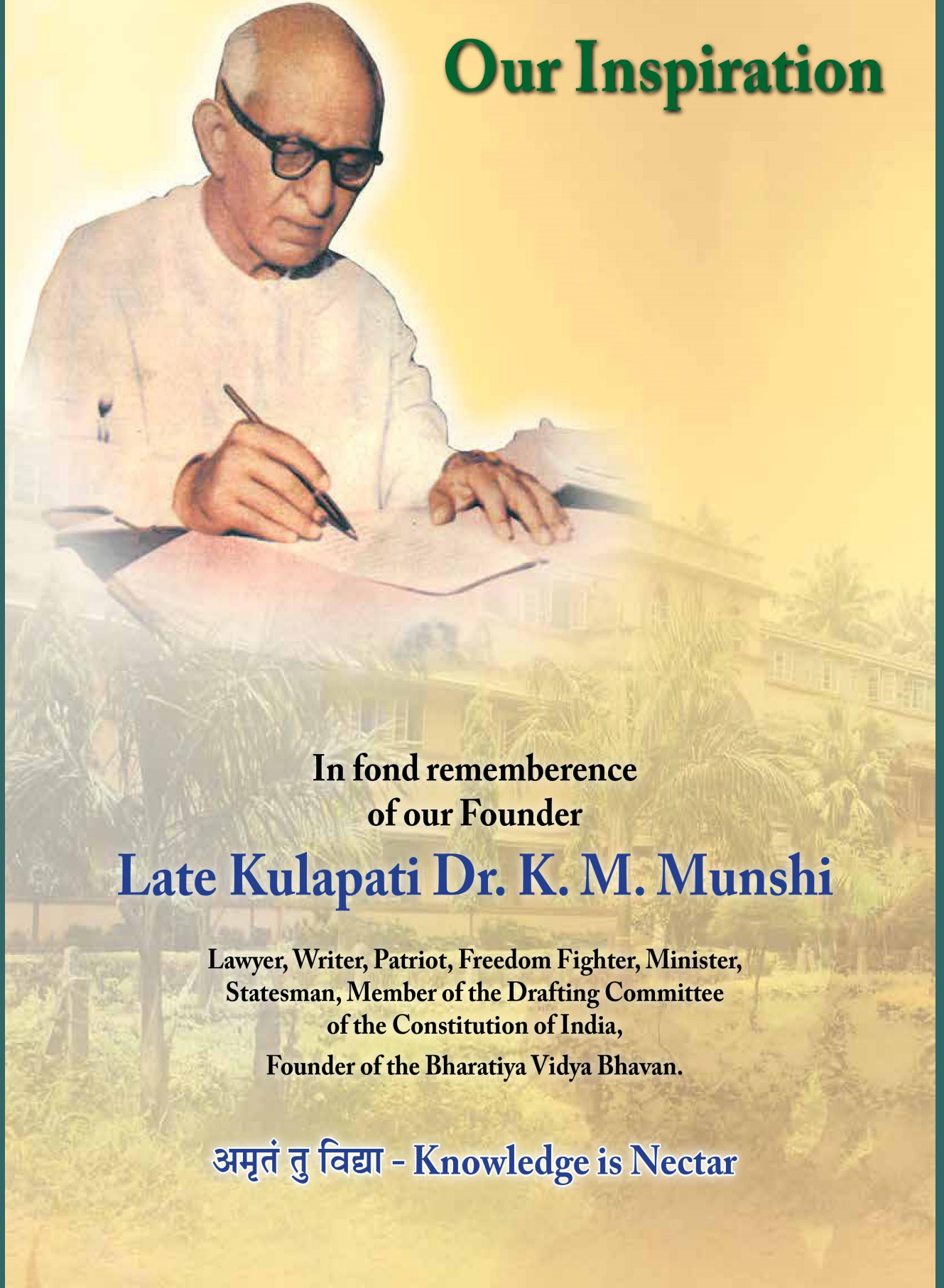
